Scheduling a Memorial/Funeral Service

We express our deepest sympathy for the loss of your loved one, rather related to you or a close friend. Feel free to call and arrange a visit with the Pastor if you have further questions.

Step 1. Select possible dates, time, and location.

- Call the Front Office at 360-445-5396 to check the Churches availability for date and desired time. Please let us know if you would like the service at the church or cemetery.
- If you would like the Pastor to take part of the service, inquire of her availability.
- Download and complete the Memorial Service paperwork, Facilities Use, and Fee Schedule from www.firconwaylutheran.org/facilities or ask the Front Office for packet.
- Would you like the event recorded or livestreamed?

Step 2. Make payment and confirm date.

- Note on the Fee Schedule that there is a difference in cost for members and nonmembers.
- Use the Fee Schedule focusing on the section for Funeral while determining expenses.
- Once paperwork is complete, payment(s) will be needed, at least a week before the service.
- Please let us know if the deceased had an Estate that we will need to consult.

Step 3. Other considerations.

- If the memorial service is to be held at the church, the pastor and the funeral director will work together.
- Please let us know if the deceased was a member of the Elks, Veteran, Local Tribe, Sons of Norway, etc., and who we should be in contact with.
- The church may be able to provide a reception (see fee schedule). Or you can arrange outside catering. (see fee schedule)
