Tony & Carrie Given, Missionaries with The Mission Society Global

A recent update sent to our congregation from Carrie Given: "Thank you for your continued support of our ministry & family. We have had a very busy and exciting summer! We have been blessed beyond measure to have 3 of our Indian and Nepali students (Chon, Chingmi and Karuna), who



are studying at LCC International University in Lithuania, living with us this summer. They were granted work visas in the USA with a partnership with their university and Chick-fil-A from May through August to work at a Chick-fil-A near us. It has been an amazing summer having these students in our home and our lives; it literally is a dream come true! Through your generous support we have been able to bless these kids with some good old American fun: watching a minor league baseball game, going to the Columbus Zoo, taking a trip to an amusement park, and so much more. The students' boss flew them to Atlanta to meet the S. Truett Cathy family at Chick-fil-A headquarters, where they learned more about the organization and possible future opportunities with Chick-fil-A. The money these students earn this summer will help them pay for some of their expenses as they pursue their Bachelor degrees."

Prayer Requests:

- For these students as they finish up their time in the States and fly back to Lithuania on August 22nd.
- For our ministry partnership with IFI (International Friendships, Inc). This partnership focuses on the South Asian students that attend Ohio State University. Pray that God uses this ministry to draw these students into life-transforming relationships with Jesus Christ.



UPCOMING CHILDREN'S MINISTRY NEEDS:






NEW LADIES BIBLE STUDY:


wonderful staff of 8 adults and 6 young people, we gave the children a
