Singles Group: Lunch today at Mt. Pleasant Assisted Living.

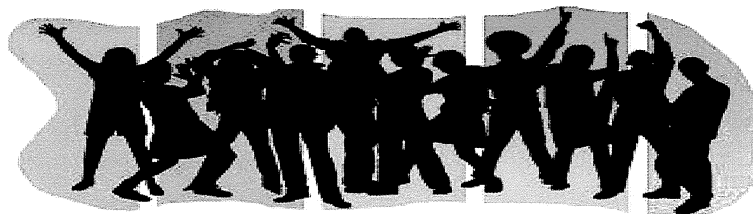
Jail Ministry Training will be offered on Friday, September 22 at 6pm and Saturday, September 23 at 8am. See Troy Campbell for more information.
