SPN Parish Council Holy Moment Thought... "What does it mean that God is a Father who keeps His promises?"

In Genesis 46, we begin to discern the character of God. Remember that Jacob is the son of Isaac and Isaac is the son of Abraham. So Jacob and his forebears are new believers in God. They are learning who this God of Abraham is.

God revealed His personality through His conversations with Jacob.

"Then he said: "I am God, the God of your father. Do not be afraid to go down to Egypt, for there I will make you a great nation. Not only will I go down to Egypt with you; I will also bring you back here, after Joseph has closed your eyes." (Genesis 46: 3-4). God's clear lesson to Jacob: God is faithful to His promises.

So, what does it mean that God is a Father who keeps His promises? There are many other examples given within scripture which showed that God kept all His promises to Abraham, Isaac, Israel, David, Mary, Simeon, and others. You will grow in faith when you learn from experience that God is faithful to His promises. Here's a recommendation...when you read the word of God, try to note and mark the verses and passages that celebrate God's faithfulness to His promises. As you start storing the truth of God's faithfulness in your mind, the power of the word of God starts affecting the way you think and act. Blessed Charles de Foucauld explained this perfectly..."His words are spirit and life; they effect what they mean as does any divine word".

Remember...God is a Father who keeps His promises. Trust Him! "...the word of the Lord remains forever." (1 Peter 1: 25) In case you are wondering...What is this word? It is the Good News that has been brought to you!!!

Please consider saying the following prayer...Lord Jesus, help me to trust in your unwavering love and saving help, especially when I meet adversities, trials, and temptations. Give me your peace when I am troubled and let me know the joy of your victory over sin and death. Amen.


