Job Description

Position Title: Girls Youth Worker

Reports to: Director of Youth and Young Adults

WEFC Philosophy of Youth Ministry

- Youth ministry exists to biblically equip growing believers to Support the body, Engage the world, and Glorify God above all.

General Job Description

- To provide ministry in the lives of the young women in the church (ages 11-18) by praying, teaching and building relationships with them, and partnering with the Director of youth in general oversight and planning of the youth program.

Job Responsibilities

Administration (approximately 3 hours per week)

- Create and plan female – focused Bible Studies for use during youth events.
- Plan two age-specific events for young women during the ministry year that foster community
- Phone new or missing girls regularly

Ministry (Approximately 4 hours per week)

- Meet with your mentor regularly during the year
- Meet with girls during the week outside of Youth Nights
- Lead female youth events
- Teach portions of the youth (coordinated with Youth Director)
- Fulfill regular Youth Sponsor duties

General Youth duties (Approximately 3 hours per week)

- Meet with the Youth director to plan the annual Youth calendar.
- Plan weekly events with the Youth Director.
- Weekly general tasks that can fit within the time allowed to help execute the week's activities
- Attend general staff meeting when possible. (to feel connected with the rest of WEFC staff team)

Skills Required:

- Ability to make relationships with youth.
- Passion for youth and young women.
- Organization
- Able to effectively self-direct.

Qualifications

- Love for God and a desire to see Christ glorified
- Active personal relationship with Jesus Christ, evidenced by action, attitude and behavior.
- A commitment to the WEFC Youth Philosophy of ministry and Statement of Faith of the Evangelical Free Church of Canada.
