

About Adam Nathanson

Adam was born in Chicago, IL in 1967 to a Colombian immigrant, he moved to Baltimore, MD at a young age and he along with his sister spent his summers in Colombia. He came to Christ at the age of 16 and quickly became involved in Church and Missions.

In May of 1993 he graduated from MBC&S and later that year married his lovely wife, Dianna. In 1995 they moved to Belo Horizonte, Brazil, to join the Schollaert family as missionaries. They served for 5 years in Brazil and while there their son Daniel was born.



In 1997 Adam met Dr. Henry when he came to share The Prayer Seminar in Brazil. Adam then teamed up with Dr. Henry to visit Cuba in November of 1998. After that visit Adam began traveling to the island once or twice a year and started a Bible School there that graduated over 100 students.

Adam has shared prayer seminars in 9 of the 16 states of Cuba over the years. During those years of first traveling to Cuba their son David was born here in the US.

In 2005 Adam and his family moved to Caracas, Venezuela as missionaries and church planters. This is their 19th year serving Venezuela, in those years they have started 2 churches and a Bible School. That Bible School has graduated over 300 students and 21 new churches have been planted throughout Venezuela since 2010 by graduates.

Currently, Adam is spending a lot of time traveling in Latin America and the United States teaching prayer seminars as well as connecting with many of the Venezuelans who have left Venezuela due to the crisis there.

In April of 2022 Adam officially became the President of The Prayer Seminar after working with Dr Henry the Founder for the last 24 years.
