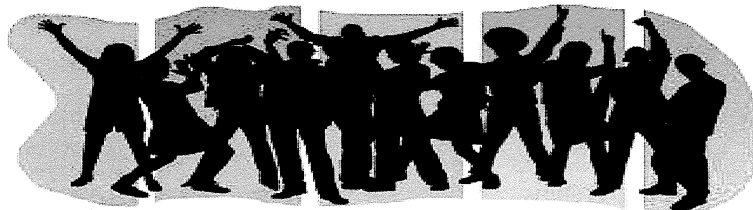
Rainbow School enrollment is open. School will begin September 15th. Contact Cindy Perryman to register.
