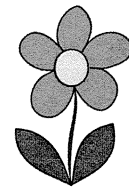
Children's Worship is for 3 year olds to the 4th grade. Dismissal is just before the sermon.

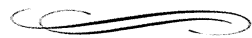
Singles Group TODAY— Lunch at El Tamarindo.

Angie Beckett's surgery went well, she is recuperating at home.

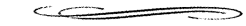
