SPN Parish Council Holy Moment Thought... "Put Out in Deeper Water"

"Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." (Luke 5: 4) is the call of Jesus to follow Him into Deeper Waters. Are you ready to follow Jesus into the deeper waters in your vocation or ministry?

Peter obeyed the command which seemingly did not make sense to an experienced fisherman. Just like when Mary heard similar words which may not have made sense from the Angel Gabriel, she answered: "Be it done to me according to Your Plan." (Luke 1: 38). Do you recall Mary's counsel to the stewards in the Marriage Feast at Cana? "Do whatever He tells you." (John 2: 5). They did what Jesus told them and water was made into high quality wine.

Our faith is expressed in obedience. Peter exercised obedience of faith and a big miracle took place. He fished all night and caught nothing. But at the words of Jesus, Peter was willing to try again. He took a second chance. Peter showed a disposition for obedience of faith. Is this why Jesus tapped him for leadership in the Church?

When God speaks His word to us through the Scriptures, locution, inspiration, prophetic individual or dream, and you do not respond with obedient action, ask yourself why? Perhaps you think it is not worth the trouble trying a second time. Please know that God is the Father of Second Chances!

When Peter responded in faith, he received his calling. "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men. When they brought their boats to the shore, they left everything and followed him." (Luke 5: 10-11)

There were others who obediently responded to Jesus and put out in Deep Water: St Maximilian Kolbe, Mother St Teresa of Kolkata, Mother Angelica of EWTN, St Maria Faustina of the Divine Mercy and many more. Jesus is calling every one of us to intimate friendship with Him in the great adventure of Evangelization. **Don't be afraid to put out in deeper water!**

Please consider saying the following prayer...Lord Jesus, increase my willingness to obey your WORD and the promptings of the Holy Spirit. Show me the way that leads to everlasting happiness and peace. May I desire you above all else and find perfect joy in doing your will. Amen.

Message from Social Hall Facilitator, Bill Robinson

Hall Update:

Our equipment is being manufactured; we are praying for returning to Parish Hall functions, sometime in November.

Scope of Work:

Set up scaffold in gym; remove mezzanine wall for access to equipment; remove old equipment. New equipment installation will require piping and wiring to be run through restrooms and lobby. Once installed, wall will be replaced; and equipment will need to complete testing. Thanks to the generosity of a number of parishioners, we have been able to replace three 100 cup Coffee Urns; two Waffle Makers and four sets of stainless steel pots and lids. Presently, we are holding donations to cover seven (7) of the twenty-five (25) tables. Donations are still be accepted for the following: Tables @\$190EA; Pots @\$80/SET; Coffee Urns @\$200/UNIT and Water Pitchers @\$10/EACH.

Bingo – we are always open to additional floor workers and kitchen help. Join a team and volunteer three (3) Sundays per year. Our main kitchen team will be retiring in June 2024. We are looking for individuals, couples, families, interested in taking on this role.

Breakfast – Looking for new volunteers to make our monthly breakfasts a success. Openings for Thursday morning potato duty; Saturday morning prep and setup; Sunday morning cooks; servers and cleanup. Shifts available to share the work. Youth are encouraged to volunteer; and this time is good for community service time for school.


