Why Pray For Israel?

- 1. Israel is still the apple of God's eye and His inheritance, close to His heart (Psa.148:14; Zech.2:8; Deut.32:8-11; Rom.11:29; Psa.33:11-12)
- 2. God's faithful servants are moved to prayer and compassion over Israel's condition (Psa.102:13-17)
- 3. God commands us to give Him and ourselves no rest until He establishes Jerusalem and makes her the praise of the earth (Isa.62:1,6-7)
- 4. God wants to give us the desire of travailing prayer for Israel's salvation (Rom.9:2-3; 10:1, 14)
- 5. God commands us to seek the spiritual and physical good of the Israeli people and to pray for the peace of Jerusalem (Psa.122:4,6-9; Rom.15:25-27; 1:16; 2:9-11)
- 6. The Jewish people's acceptance of Messiah Jesus (Jesus) will lead to life from the dead world-wide revival of unprecedented magnitude (Rom.11:15; Acts 3:19-21)
- 7. Jesus linked His second coming to Israel's national turning to Him (Matt.23:39).

Pray for the Peace of Jerusalem

For Zion's sake I will not hold My peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her salvation as a lamp that burns.- Isaiah 62:1

Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: "May they prosper who love you. Peace be within your walls, Prosperity within your palaces." For the sake of my brethren and companions, I will now say, "Peace be within you." Because of the house of the LORD our God I will seek your good.- Psalm 122:6-9

For I will gather all the nations to battle against Jerusalem. -Zachariah 14:2

Jesus will bring military breakthrough.

In that day the Lord will defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; the one who is feeble among them in that day shall be like David, and the house of. David shall be like God, like the Angel of the LORD before them. It shall be in that day that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem.- Zechariah 12:8-9
