Sermon Series on Relationships

Every Wednesday night of the semester we gather to worship the Lord and hear from his word. This semester instead of preaching through a book of the Bible, we've gone through a series on relationships. All of us are thinking about relationships and interacting with each other all the time. Students are no different.

Too often our thoughts and ideas of relationships and relating are more impacted by current cultural moments and things we hear and see from our peers rather than the word of God. We've spent an entire semester looking at relationships, what God has to say about them, and how to apply the wisdom of God's word to how we relate with others.

Some highlights from our semester sermon series so far...

• Genesis 1-3 and what it means to be made in the image of God and how sin impacts all of our relationships.

- Psalm 139 and relating to the all-knowing and omnipresent
 God who knows us intimately and is always with us.
- Friendship and the many Proverbs that point us to loving friends, encouraging friends, challenging friends, and bearing one another's burdens in love.
- 1 Corinthians 7 and the reality of how Paul talks about the goodness and gift that singleness is and how in our singleness we have amazing opportunities to serve the Lord.
- Matthew 18 and the goodness of forgiveness.

 One night we had a Q&A discussion and Anna Caroline and I answered lots of questions about dating, marriage, and sexual ethics. We had fun!

We do a lot of fun things in the early stages of the semester with the hopes of meeting and connecting with new students.


We want to have fun and also show them the welcoming, kind heart of Jesus towards new people. Thank you for praying for these events and our interactions with students.
