The Changing Role of Canada's Senate

An Evening in Edgemont Village with the Hon. Yuen Pau Woo, Member of the Canadian Senate



In November 2016, Yuen Pau Woo was appointed to the Canadian Senate and spends his weeks in Ottawa sitting as an Independent Senator for BC. He became Leader of the Independent Senators Group (ISG) in September 2017. In this position, he has a crucial role in leading the newly created ISG (which now forms a majority in the Senate) as the Senate moves into new areas of responsibility and action. This is one of the most significant changes in Canadian history in how our federal Parliament operates.
