

Dear friends in Christ,

We know it's time – time to get our hearts and minds ready for the birth of the Savior. Meditating on the words of the gospel of Mark we hear:

"Prepare the way of the Lord; make his paths straight."

Many of our paths in life are not straight forward. Most of the time we take meandering routes with twists and turns and perhaps even a metaphorical detour. Setting our eyes on the Lord and directing ourselves toward God can be hard. We often turn to prayer as a last resort instead of our first stop.

As way of preparation, I'd like to challenge you in this season of love, peace and sometimes stress, to start your day with God. That might be as simple as when you get up, to thank the Lord for the day and ask God to walk with you in it. (God's always with us, but sometimes asking for a divine escort can make the day feel even better.)

Other options might be reading a daily devotional, picking one of the gospels and reading a little each day or telling yourself you will find three ways God is working in the world today. However you decide to spend time with God this Advent, preparing for the Christmas season, is up to you.

Know that I will be praying **for** all of you during this Christmas season. And if you have special prayer needs, I'd be happy to pray **with** you as well. God desires for us to walk with each other in our joy and sorrow. The path we walk together might not be straight – but the way becomes clearer with help from one another and especially from the Lord.

God's path to us is clear and constant. May our path to God this season be filled with grace and peace.
