"And do this, understanding the present time: The hour has already come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed." –Romans 13:11

KEY VERSE

"Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and not give up." –Luke 18:1

Have you ever started something really hard and wanted to quit before you finished? Maybe you've worked on a puzzle that seems impossible or you've tried to play a sport that is a lot harder than it looks. So many things in our lives are great when we begin them, but when anything gets just a little hard, we are tempted to give up and quit.

Our key verse today talks about a parable that Jesus told His disciples. He shared with them a story about a woman whose husband had died, and someone was being unfair to her so much that she needed to see a judge. This judge did not care about the woman, nor did he follow God, but every day, this woman went before him and asked for his help without losing patience. The judge ignored her for a while, but she was so persistent that it started getting on his nerves. Finally, he told her he would honor her request since she did not stop asking for what she needed. It wasn't because he cared; instead, it was because she would not give up. You can read this in Luke 18:1–8.

Jesus told the disciples that God is far better than an uncaring judge. When His people do not give up and continue to pray, He will surely hear and act on their behalf because of His great love for us. Sometimes when we pray, it might seem like God isn't listening because He doesn't say yes immediately to every prayer. You can be confident that God always hears the prayers of His people and that He will answer. Sometimes, the answer is yes. Sometimes, the answer is no. Then, there are other times when God asks us to wait. His answers are perfect, even when we are impatient.

Now is the time to pray. We don't have to be a certain age or have any special job. God is ready to hear us because He loves when His kids pray to Him. It might be tempting to not want to be still or quiet. Maybe you think praying is hard, but it is simply talking to God! You can pray out loud or silently. God looks and listens to our hearts, so don't give up, and don't lose heart. God hears our prayers!

Today, let's pray that we will be faithful to prayer. As our faith grows, God will increase our ability to pray! Let's ask Him to help our families, churches, and The Alliance to be faithful prayer people who trust God's timing!

"Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy." –1 Peter 2:10

Is there something you dream about becoming when you grow up? Do you know what it might take to become that? Are you hoping to be an athlete, a doctor, or a professional singer? "Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks." –John 4:23

KEY VERSE

"Now, you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it." –1 Corinthians 12:27
