



Walk for Reconciliation: Organizations Participation

Thank you for your interest in supporting the reconciliation movement in Canada! Your participation is incredibly meaningful. This event is part of a positive movement to build better relationships among Indigenous peoples and all Canadians. This bold vision calls on everyone of all ages, all backgrounds, all cultures and all faiths to come together as communities and as individuals.

Below are ways in which your organization can become more meaningfully involved with the Walk for Reconciliation in Vancouver, September 24th 2017.

- **Register a Walk team**

Register your organization for a walk team:

1. Click on the website link: <http://reconciliationcanada.ca/walk-for-reconciliation-2017/>
2. Scroll down and click the register button
3. Click "Sign up"
4. Create an account
5. Scroll down to accept the waiver
6. Register as an individual, join a team, or create a team (note: if you sign up as an individual you will later have the option to join or create a team. Simply visit the walk page, login, and then click on "team" to create or join a team).
7. Customize your personal walk page (this will appear within the Reconciliation Canada website opposed to Facebook etc).

Once you have registered your team online, other participants will be able to register to join the team. As the team captain, you will be able to log into your account and see all the members on your team. You will also be able to send messages to team members and invite others to join your team.

- **Create a Walk Team Banner**

We welcome Walk Teams to celebrate by creating banners for the Walk. However, please ensure that your banners are no longer than 15ft wide and 4ft tall.

- **Buy Walk Team T-Shirts**
