End of Year Contributions

To count as 2023 charitable contributions the donation must be PHYSICALLY received in the year 2023. The ONLY exception to this rule, is donations that are mailed through the United States Postal Service, donations are considered PHYSICALLY received on the date they are POSTMARKED, not the date they are delivered.

Examples:

- J writes a check for 12/31/23 and drops it in giving box on 12/31/23
 = 2023 Contribution.
- J writes a check for 12/31/23 and it is POSTMARKED 12/31/23 but not received until 1/3/24 = 2023 Contribution.
- J writes a check for 12/31/23 and hands it to the office staff at class on 1/3/24 = 2024 Contribution.

Contribution reports for tax purposes will be mailed by 1/20/2024.
