## **Further explanation**

Many weeks on this guide have special dates noted. These are included as additional prayer reminders.

Observances in **bold** are dates in the Christian Year and should drive us to pray specifically in terms of what we are remembering on those days.

Observances in *italics* are those that our culture has deemed important. They are good reminders of ways to pray for our neighbors.

## As you pray...

... Ask God if the psalm speaks truth about you and your situation, or if He needs to change you.
... Look for ways that God fulfills the hope found in the Psalm (hint: it's often going to be fulfilled in the Incarnation - the coming of Jesus to this earth).
... Look for sins that you have committed against God and other people. Confess those and repent to God.
... Rejoice that the God who gave us this book, and the whole Bible, is the same God who is living inside all of His followers today.
... Pray with other people! We were never meant to do this alone.

## Praying the Psalms in 2024

The Book of Psalms is the prayer book of the Bible. It is what Jesus grew up learning to pray alongside His fellow Israelites. It is also the book that Jesus quotes from the most often in the Gospel Narratives. While Jesus taught His Disciples how to pray (Matthew 6.9-13), the Father had given His people this resource for a thousand years leading up to the incarnation of Christ. And His Holy Spirit has preserved it for the benefit of His people ever since.

We want to grow in our dependence on God, or rather, grow in *acknowledging* that dependence, and there is no better way to do so than by going before Him in prayer. As we turn to 2024, you are invited to join us in praying through this book. Inside you will find a weekly prayer guide that provides three psalms a week for you to repeat back to God, meditate on, journal about, or even try to memorize individually, as a family, or with your friends.
