




I will respect all of those who are placed in authority over me. Without risking my safety, I will listen and participate to the best of my ability.

Non- Refundable Deposit - \$100

Full Registration Fee - \$290 (less deposit)

Estimated Total Cost - \$625 (less registration fee)

- Full amount is due June 23, 2024
