### PROGRESS ALONG THE LONG AND WINDING ROAD

The men were notified of U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) appointments for an October 27th attorney and interpreter practice session and a November 1st interview. These two events move them closer to asylum. Keep in mind that a *longer than fifteen-month backlog* remains until Congress acts. **Many thanks to those who participated in the letter-writing campaign.** The men are guardedly optimistic (and, <u>very</u> excited).

Both men participated in another six-week Civics Class on "Education and Work" which started in September. Their next Civic Class--starting this month--will be "Banking and Finance", ending in January.

#### **SMLC TEAM**

In an effort to give the men a well-rounded experience, the Team exposes them to as many American adventures as time and opportunities allow. In September, the men revisited Chicago to see Buckingham Fountain in Grant Park. They were able to see the fountain during daylight hours, then at night with the cycles of the fountain changing colors. They took advantage of the "photo ops" from many angles with a rainbow of colors.

Last March, both men visited Door County for a weekend, experiencing three state parks and a county park while meeting new friends. They both spent a weekend in Wisconsin Dells in October where they went to two state parks and rode the famous "Ducks". They will return to the Dells this month for more memorable adventures.

The Team has made a concerted effort to keep the men healthy and fit in accordance with state and federal protocols. While medical and dental care in Afghanistan were lacking, the men are now each on par with their American cohorts.
