

CWC STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

You will see posted in our downstairs classrooms at church new posters showing our CWC Student Expectations for our children's programs. The goal of these expectations is to create a safe space where all students can learn.

We expect our students to show Respect for People (be kind in your words and actions to others, listen when others speak and be where you are supposed to be) and Respect for Property (if you make a mess clean it up and don't do anything that would damage the property of the church or others).

If a child is having difficulty following the required expectations for behavior there are escalating consequences to help them participate in the activities appropriately. First a warning would be given by the teacher or leader to stop the inappropriate behavior. If a problem continues the leader will create a new environment for the student (for example change their seating, remove distraction, etc.). If needed the next level of correction will be a time out and the student will sit with a leader or helper. Finally, if the behavior is not corrected, the child will be removed from the class to be with parents/guardians or a program director and asked to try again next week.
