





Come and Worship!

Planning worship is one of my tasks and one of my joys. I've been spending more time lately figuring out how our pieces of worship fit together and what speaks to those who are in our worship space.

What people long for as they worship God is as varied as the people themselves. On any given Sunday, what speaks to each soul is impossible to predict. Hopefully for each of you, there is a high point—something that connects you with God and makes your soul sing so you share that feeling with another. I was scanning through the book of 1 Corinthians this past week and stumbled on a heading that said,

"Orderly Worship." I was intrigued. What did Paul, the writer of this letter in the New Testament, have to say about worship?!

1 Corinthians 14:26 says: "What should be done then, my friends? When you come together, each one has a hymn, a lesson, a revelation, a tongue or an interpretation. Let all things be done for building up." Now I don't agree with everything Paul writes—but wow did that last sentence resonate with me. As we are planning worship, or anything else associated with the church, what if we passed it through the "building up" filter? Is this going to build people up? That doesn't mean everything is going to be sunshine and roses. There are tough topics and difficult concepts we do need to tackle. They can build us up toward action.

This month and perhaps for months to come, these words from 1 Corinthians seem like a good place to start as we worship and share the love of Christ. Does this build up? Is this strengthening the love of God and helping people know they are loved by God?

We pray, "Build us up, Lord, build us up." So that we can build for others. Peace to you, beloved of God!
