

ENTERING COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Each year St. Mary's Lutheran Church Endowment Foundation awards a limited number of scholarships to students who are communicant members of St. Mary's and enrolled as full-time students at an accredited college or technical school. No scholarship will be awarded for travel, graduate, post-graduate or professional study. Scholarships are to be used for tuition, fees, books, supplies and/or equipment required for courses of instruction. All students are reviewed on the same scale and late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

In order to be considered for a scholarship, it is necessary for all students to submit all the following supporting documentation:

- Application
- Most Current OFFICAL Grade Transcript (not a grade report)
- ACT/SAT Score Report
- Essay (what has guided your life to this point and what are your hopes for the future as well as what more do you want the committee to know about you.)
- Resume of achievements/accomplishment, school involvement, community involvement, St.
 Mary's or other church involvement, and work experience since the beginning of high school.
 This information if from the last year only.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Applications will be available online at www.stmaryslutheran.org beginning March 1. Completed Application must be postmarked on or before April 30. (applications without an eligible postmark will not be considered) Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 2. Submit the completed application form, GPA transcripts, SAT/ACT Transcripts, essay and resume and any other supporting materials in a flat large envelope addressed to:

- 3. The Scholarship Committee of the Foundation will review applications received and make a recommendation to the Board. Applicants will be notified of the Foundation Board's decision. Students will receive their award at a service to be determined after the board has made a recommendation. Checks will be made out to the student and their schools.
