# Minister's Message

We do not live to ourselves, and we do not die to ourselves. If we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord; so then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's. For to this end Christ died and lived again, so that he might be Lord of both the dead and the living.

Siblings in Christ,

"We can't lose!" said one of our members after our Gladwin Heights AGM, and she was right both financially and theologically.

At Gladwin Heights we have a plan to redevelop our building. Given the state of our finances and the large costs involved in such a project, we have no choice but to look for loans from various sources. This is, admittedly, a risk, in that there are several ways the project might go wrong, although Gayle and Len have worked carefully to mitigate those risks. But even if something goes wrong, members and trustees are not personally liable, and we have the option of paying any debts out of the equity of the building.

If this is true financially, it is even more true theologically. If we redevelop the building, I am excited about the exciting ministry opportunities it offers. We will be in daily contact with many and diverse people. Even if it does not result in better cashflow, more people in worship, and more volunteer hands, we are paving the way legislatively with the city for other churches to follow in our footsteps more easily. We will use our land, purchased for the sake of the Gospel, to further the Gospel: to demonstrate God's love for every human being by providing much-needed space for housing, childcare, and worship. "If live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord; so then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's."

Siblings in Christ, this is as true in Mission as it is in Abbotsford; it is as true in our private lives as it is in our institutional life. You belong to God, and if you live your life in God then you are a success whether the world agrees or not. Your discipleship does not

depend on others' approval, and you are a part of the family of God by the fact of your birth. Your age, race, gender, sexuality etc. are not conditions of your beauty, but simply details of it.

You are loved; you are worthy; you are Christ's. Do not be afraid to be daring with your life.
