#### Scripture:

## Psalm 139:13-18 NLT

Oh yes, you shaped me first inside, then out; you formed me in my mother's womb. I thank you, High God you're breathtaking! Body and soul, I am marvelously made! I worship in adoration—what a creation! You know me inside and out, you know every bone in my body; You know exactly how I was made, bit by bit, how I was sculpted from nothing into something. Like an open book, you watched me grow from conception to birth; all the stages of my life were spread out before you, Your thoughts—how rare, how beautiful! God, I'll ever comprehend them! I couldn't even begin to count them—any more than I could count the sand of the sea.

## John 12:1-7 NLT

Six days before the Passover celebration began, Jesus arrived in Bethany, the home of Lazarus—the man he had raised from the dead. <sup>2</sup>A dinner was prepared in Jesus' honor. Martha served, and Lazarus was among those who ate with him. <sup>3</sup>Then Mary took a twelve-ounce jar of expensive perfume made from essence of nard, and she anointed Jesus' feet with it, wiping his feet with her hair. The house was filled with the fragrance. <sup>4</sup>But Judas Iscariot, the disciple who would soon betray him, said, <sup>5</sup> "That perfume was worth a year's wages. It should have been sold and the money given to the poor." <sup>6</sup>Not that he cared for the poor—he was a thief, and since he was in charge of the disciples' money, he often stole some for himself. <sup>7</sup>Jesus replied, "Leave her alone. She did this in preparation for my burial. <sup>8</sup>You will always have the poor among you, but you will not always have me."
