Group Questions – March 3, 2024

1. Opening: Name some godly women that you know personally and that you respect greatly. Explain why?
2. **Read 1 Samuel 25.** What stands out to you from this chapter and/or from the sermon today? Why?
3. **Read 1 Peter 3:3-6** and focus on the last sentence. Why is it important for women to “do what is right and do not give way to fear”? Explain why the Bible might be emphasizing this point? How can we emphasize this same point today?
4. In what ways was Abigail intelligent, strong, and yet submissive to God ordained authority/headship? Answer the following:

5. What can we do, as individuals and as a church, to encourage women by the example of Abigail (and other Biblical examples)?
6. Talk about the church’s plans for Good Friday and Easter Sunday. Discuss ways that we can reach out to unchurched friends, relatives, neighbors, and co-workers to join us at one or both of these events. How can we do that? Develop a prayer list – people that your group is praying for, in advance, so that God will open the doors of receptivity that these people will join us Easter Weekend.
