This week's special offering will support the ***Loaves & Fishes Growing Project of South Simcoe County*** (L&F). The ***Loaves and Fishes*** project grows crops wherein farmers donate land and labour. Donations from churches, individuals and agribusinesses pay for the inputs. For every \$1 donated to ***Loaves and Fishes***, we produce about \$2.50 from crops. These proceeds are then sent to the ***Canadian Foodgrains Bank (CFGB)*** where they are further multiplied by matching government grants (up to 4:1).

The Canadian Foodgrains Bank is a partnership of Canadian churches and church-based agencies that work to support international programs and increase the involvement of Canadians in reducing global hunger on an immediate and sustainable basis.

World Renew, being one of the ***Canadian Foodgrains Bank*** member agencies, accesses funds from the ***Canadian Foodgrains Bank*** for its food assistance programs. In 2021, ***Loaves and Fishes*** grew 106 acres of crops resulting in \$102,000 being sent to Canadian Foodgrains Bank. (This is before the government matching was added in). 2024 will mark 27 years since the establishment of the ***Loaves and Fishes Growing Project***.
