Psalm 118:1-2, 14-24

- 1 Give thanks to the Lord who is good; *the mercy of the Lord endures for ever.
- 2 Let Israel now proclaim, * "The mercy of the Lord endures for ever."
- 14 The Lord is my strength and my song, * and has become my salvation.
- 15 There is a sound of exultation and victory * in the tents of the righteous:
- 16 "The mighty hand of the Lord has triumphed! * the mighty hand of the Lord has triumphed!"

- 23 This is the Lord's doing, * and it is marvellous in our eyes.
- 24 On this day the Lord has acted; * we will rejoice and be glad in it.
