The Scriptures tell us that during the 40-day period after His resurrection from the dead, and prior to His Ascension into the clouds, Jesus made as many as a dozen different appearances to His followers. The most intriguing of these for me has always been His appearance to two of his followers, on the day of His resurrection, on the road from Jerusalem to Emmaus. What is intriguing is that even though they knew Him and had followed Him, they did not recognize Him as He walked alongside them. This was clearly by Jesus' design. But it raises a question for me. How often have I been journeying somewhere, and Jesus has been walking right alongside me, and I have failed to recognize His presence? During the month of April this year, as we journey through the weeks following Easter and leading up to Pentecost, may we all be attentive to the reality that Jesus is walking alongside of us, in whatever each of us is going through. And may that attunement to His presence cause our hearts to burn within us.
