This week's special offering will support **Thrive: Safe Church**. On July 1st, a new agency of the Christian Reformed Church in North America officially began.

**Thrive** is a consolidation of nine former, small ministries of the Christian Reformed Church of North America, each of which had its own synodical mandate and budget: Chaplaincy and Care Ministry, Faith Formation Ministries, Disability concerns, Diversity, Safe Church Ministry, Pastor Church Resources, Race Relations, Social Justice and Worship Ministries. All of these ministries have re-organized into a single entity, which was endorsed by Synod in 2023 and given a new mandate focused on encouraging and equipping congregations. **Thrive: Safe Church** ministry equips congregations in abuse awareness, prevention, and response. They help build communities where the value of each person is honoured; where people are free to worship and grow free from abuse. Where abuse has occurred, the response is compassion and justice that foster healing. **Thrive: Safe Church** pursues that vision by offering training and support to volunteer safe church team members so that they can be resources for their congregations and classes.
