

First / Old Testament reading – Micah 7:14–20 – Jay Teo, Anne Reuter

(Page 760 of the red Bible)

- ¹⁴ Shepherd your people with your staff, the flock of your inheritance, which lives by itself in a forest, in fertile pasture-lands. Let them feed in Bashan and Gilead as in days long ago.
- ¹⁵ 'As in the days when you came out of Egypt, I will show them my wonders.'
- ¹⁶ Nations will see and be ashamed, deprived of all their power.
- They will put their hands over their mouths and their ears will become deaf.
- ¹⁷They will lick dust like a snake, like creatures that crawl on the ground.
- They will come trembling out of their dens; they will turn in fear to the LORD our God and will be afraid of you.
- who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of his inheritance?
- You do not stay angry for ever but delight to show mercy.
- ¹⁹ You will again have compassion on us; you will tread our sins underfoot and hurl all our iniquities into the depths of the sea.
- ²⁰ You will be faithful to Jacob, and show love to Abraham, as you pledged on oath to our ancestors in days long ago.

Third / Gospel reading - Matthew 12:38-42 - Linda Dickson, David Hamer

(Page 793 of the red Bible)

³⁹ He answered, 'A wicked and adulterous generation asks for a sign! But none will be given it except the sign of the prophet Jonah. ⁴⁰ For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. ⁴¹ The men of Nineveh will stand up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it; for they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and now something greater than Jonah is here. ⁴² The Queen of the South will rise at the judgment with this generation and condemn it; for she came from the ends of the earth to listen to Solomon's wisdom, and now something greater than Solomon is here.

⁸ For I tell you that Christ has become a servant of the Jews on behalf of God's truth, so that the promises made to the patriarchs might be confirmed ⁹ and, moreover, that the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy. As it is written:

¹² And again, Isaiah says,

¹³ May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

³⁸ Then some of the Pharisees and teachers of the law said to him, 'Teacher, we want to see a sign from you.'
