2 Peter 1:16-21 – See the Light

Peter preached Jesus as Lord and Savior because he saw who Jesus was and what Jesus did. Peter's eyewitness account encourages us to have a similar personal experience with Jesus.

Peter saw Jesus' majesty.

Peter saw the fulfillment of God's Word.

We respond and apply the word of God we have heard by seeing the light.

May your fellowship be with the Father and with his son, Jesus Christ. May you walk in the light, as he is in the light. May you have fellowship with one another. May the blood of Jesus purify you from all sin. May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all. (1 John 1:3,7, 2 Corinthians 13:14)

Discussion Questions:

- What did it mean for Peter to have been an eyewitness of Jesus' majesty?
- How does Peter's experience compare to other accounts of witnessing God's glory and majesty?
- Why was the transfiguration of Jesus so significant for Peter?
- How was Peter an eyewitness of the fulfillment of God's Word?
- How do we know that the "prophetic message" refers to the entire scriptures?
- What does it mean that the prophets (Bible authors) "though human, spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit"?
- How can we follow Peter's example to become eyewitnesses of Jesus' majesty and the fulfillment of the Word of God?
