The impact made by Good New Church
April – November 2021

Since our birth on Easter Sunday, April 4, 2021, the generosity of Good News Church family has made an impact on our relationships and the communities we serve.

Mercy & Outreach Ministry Needs

- \$37,850 (28% of all donations) have been given to outreach ministry and mercy needs.

Weekly Worship Service

- Good News Church serves approximately 60+ people attending weekly service.
- The inaugural Easter Service (4-4-21) served 160 people in attendance.

People Impacted by Good News Church (527)

We estimate that 525 people (297 via outreach / 230 via weekly worship) and households have been impacted in a positive way by Good News Church.

- **Outreach - People & Households Impacted (297)**
 - 55 children participating in the Sugar Hill Elementary Good News Club
 - 150 dads connected with through LHS Longhorn Dads
 - 30 dads invested in through LHS Longhorn Dads
 - 50 dads connected with and invested in through LMS Longhorn Dads
 - 12 Lenox Park neighborhood women connected with via Hillside craft night
