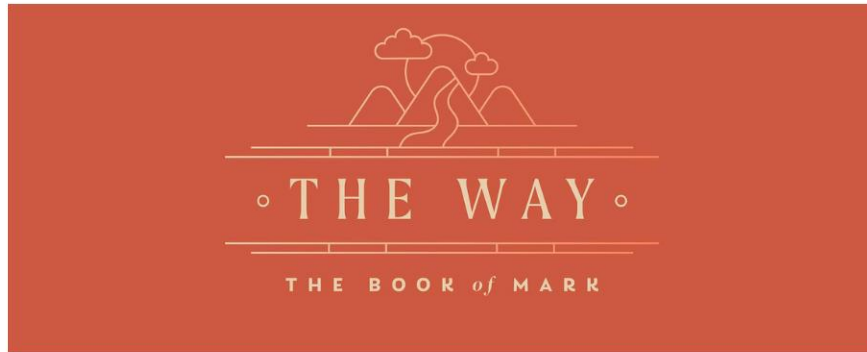
1. Live a life of humility.
