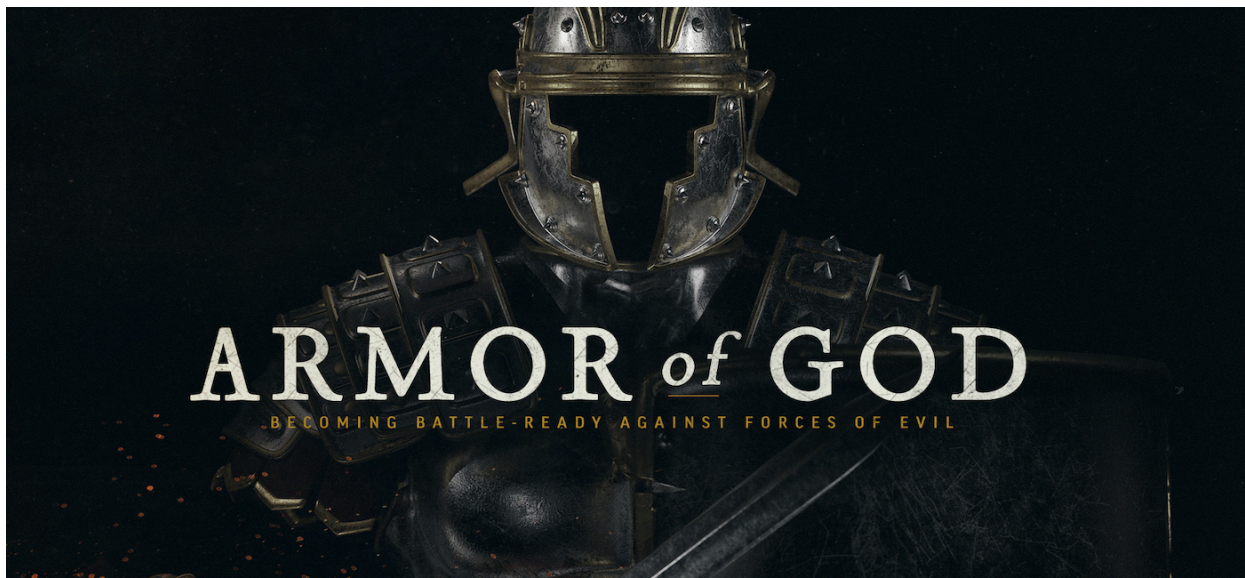
This event includes:

Belt of Truth

How do we determine what is true? Not my truth or your truth, but the actual truth.

Ultimately, God determines truth as Creator, Savior, Master and Lord. As our Designer, He defines truth. He cannot lie. We can trust what He says to us in His Word.

Ephesians 6:13-14

Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place...

We buckle up because we are at war. Putting on the belt of truth is to prepare for battle. It is going from leisure to action, like changing out of flip flops into running shoes.

What does it mean to wear the truth? Are we to put on Christ or are we to be truthful? Yes!

Jesus and His Gospel is the truth

John 14:6

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Ephesians 1:13

And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation...

Anything other than God's truth is wayward; and it requires repentance.

Standing for truth can be difficult in the face of opposition or when we feel outnumbered.

**Standing for truth can be offensive.
Standing for truth has consequences.**

One final reminder as we return to battle: Victory belongs to God.
