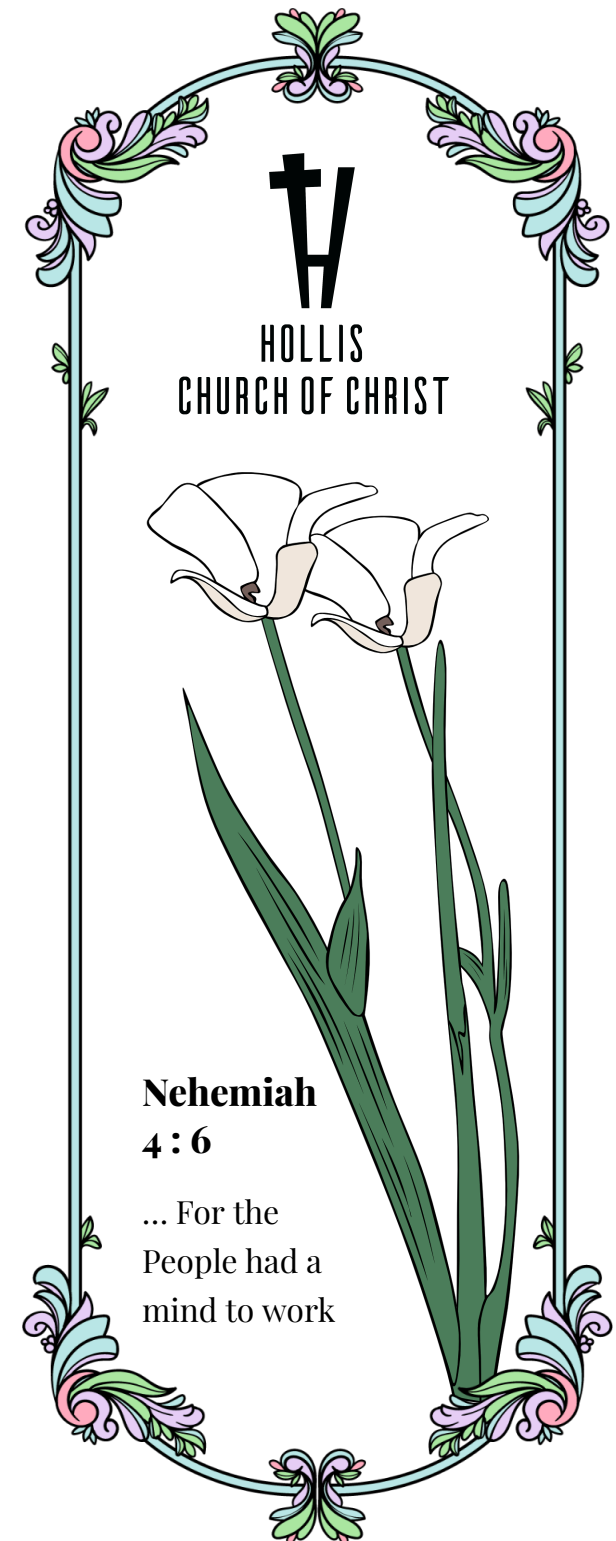

Preacher: Brother Freeman

Scripture: Ephesians 3 : 14 – 19

Title: Salvation - The Joy of Knowing (Series)

MESSAGE



This passage is a prayer by Paul. From a Jewish standpoint, this is the humblest prayer you could make because you are admitting to being totally dependent on Christ.

Hebrews 11 : 1 – 6 — Does Christ have a home in your life? When the Lord sets up residency in your life (done by faith), you can become what God wants you to become. Faith is like tree roots, the deeper you go the more nourishment you get. The wider your roots the more stability you have.

Ephesians 3 : 18 — Many of us suffer from connectedness in Jesus because we lack a connection to each other. To **comprehend** with all the saints we must have togetherness.

V. 20 — Will we get ourselves in line for the Spirit to work? The Church is no greater than what we want it to be, no more spiritual than what we are. The Church in Ephesus forgot to love Jesus. When we live how we ought to everything falls in line.
