## REMINDER OF LAST WEEK

May 5, 2024

**Scripture:** Luke 17 : 11 - 19

**Title:** Where are the nine?

## MESSAGE

Jesus came across 10 lepers who were accepted by neither the Jews nor the Samaritans because of their affliction. They asked Jesus to have mercy on them. He instructed them to go see the priests. Jesus intends to heal them but never broke the law of Moses by doing this. In those times priests must give the stamp of approval on whether or not someone had leprosy (Lev. 14). Jesus can't "cure" them if it's not recognized as an illness. They weren't healed on the spot, they were healed as they walked, as they obeyed the command. The act of going was the act of faith. Sometimes we may ask for something but it may not be answered how and when we expect it, but it does get answered. "Our faith moves mountains When our faith moves us" - unknown by Speaker. We have to have active religion, not passive religion. 1 person among the 10 lepers, the Samaritan - the one hated - recognized Jesus healed them all and gave thanks. Sometimes when we're unappreciative God takes things away to teach us a lesson.
