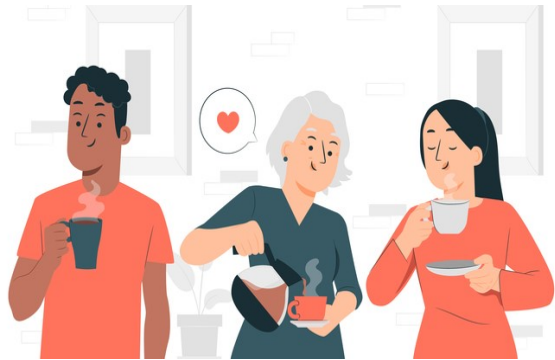
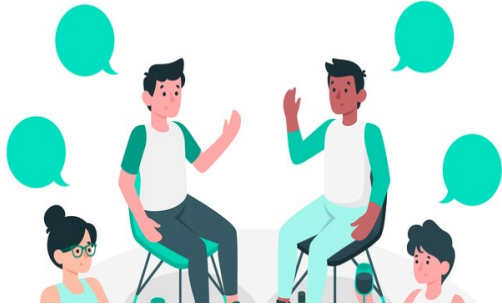

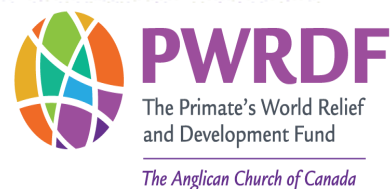
Welcome to Marlon Narcisso
