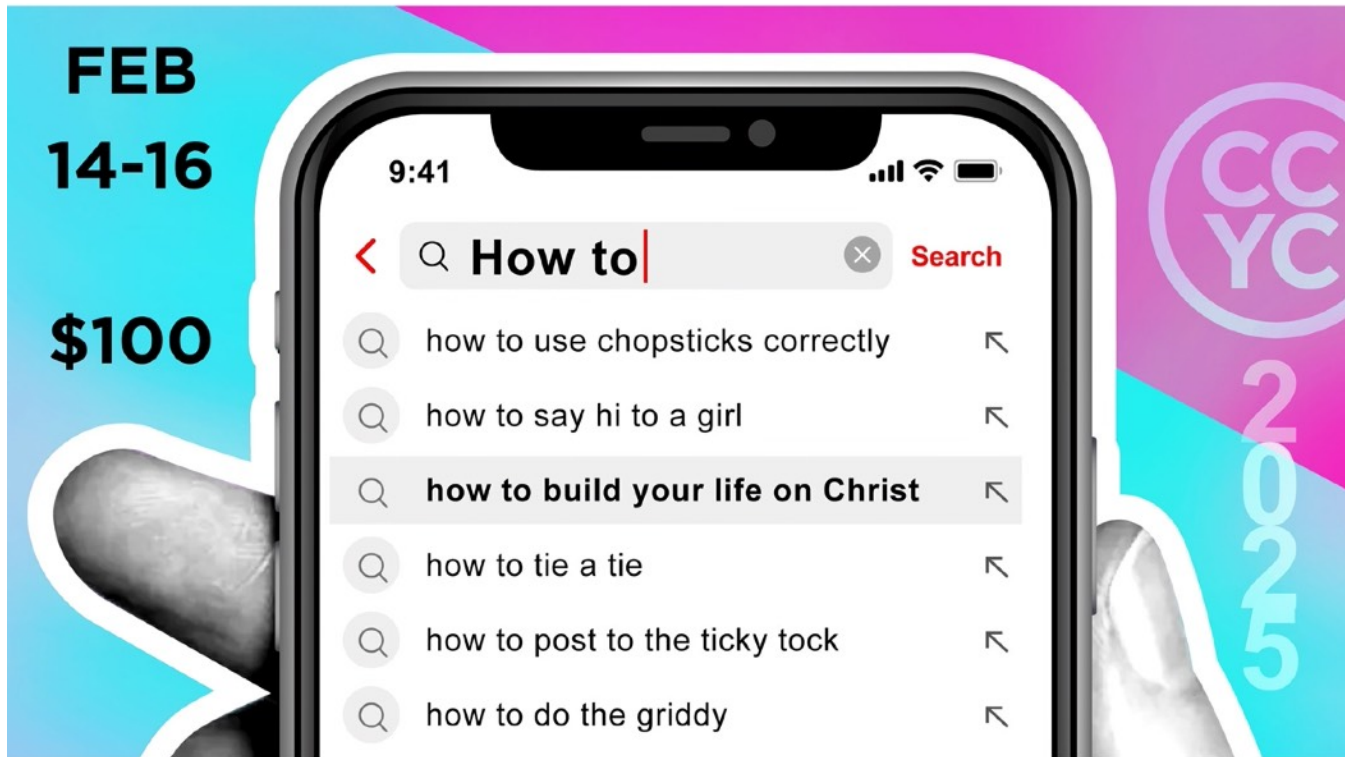

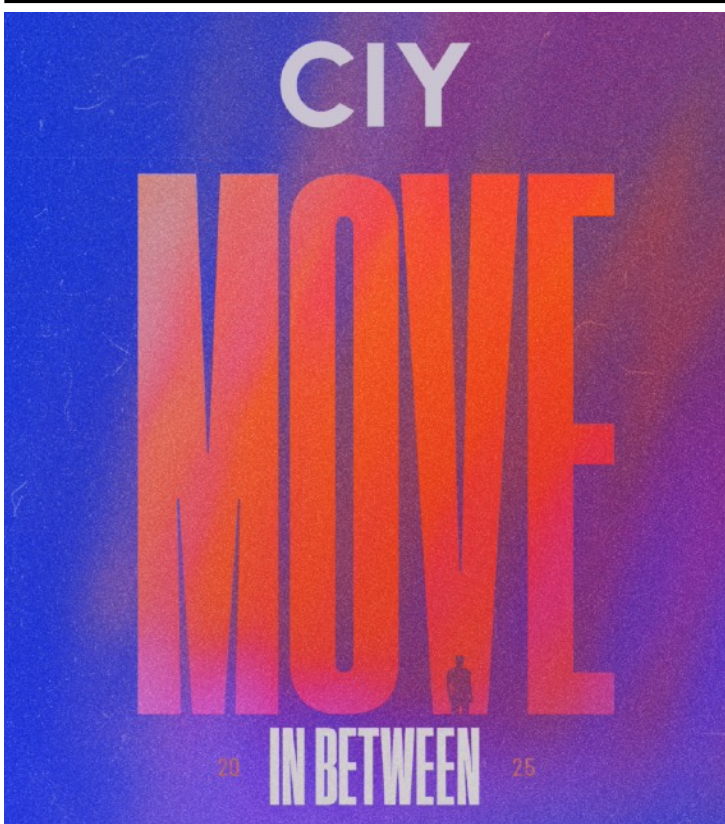


CCYC IS AN AMAZING WEEKEND CONFERENCE FOR ALL MIDDLE AND HIGH STUDENTS!

WEEK 3 REPENTANT

**The people of Israel, and the rest of the world at the time needed to repent.
And our world, today, needs to repent.**

This message is for you.

Jeremiah 7:1-3a

¹ This is the word that came to Jeremiah from the Lord: ² “Stand at the gate of the Lord’s house and there proclaim this message. “ ‘Hear the word of the Lord, all you people of Judah who come through these gates to worship the Lord. ³ This is what the Lord Almighty, the God of Israel, says:

**God is saying to Israel, through Jeremiah, you can’t just come here
to My house once a week and then act like the devil every other day.**

Jeremiah 7:3b-4

³ “...Reform your ways and your actions, and I will let you live in this place. ⁴ Do not trust in deceptive words and say, “This is the temple of the Lord; the temple of the Lord, the temple of the Lord!”

as living obediently every day.**

What is Biblical repentance?

Repentance is more than just regret.

Repentance is more than just confession.

Biblical repentance is actually changing the direction of your life.

**The real tell tale sign that we are not truly sincere
is that we are not committed to change.**

Worldly sorrow focuses on our shame and is passive.

Godly sorrow focuses on your behavior and is active.

¹⁰ Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to life and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death.

1 John 1:9

⁹ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
