Jesus - Matthew 5:27-28 - Greek Translation

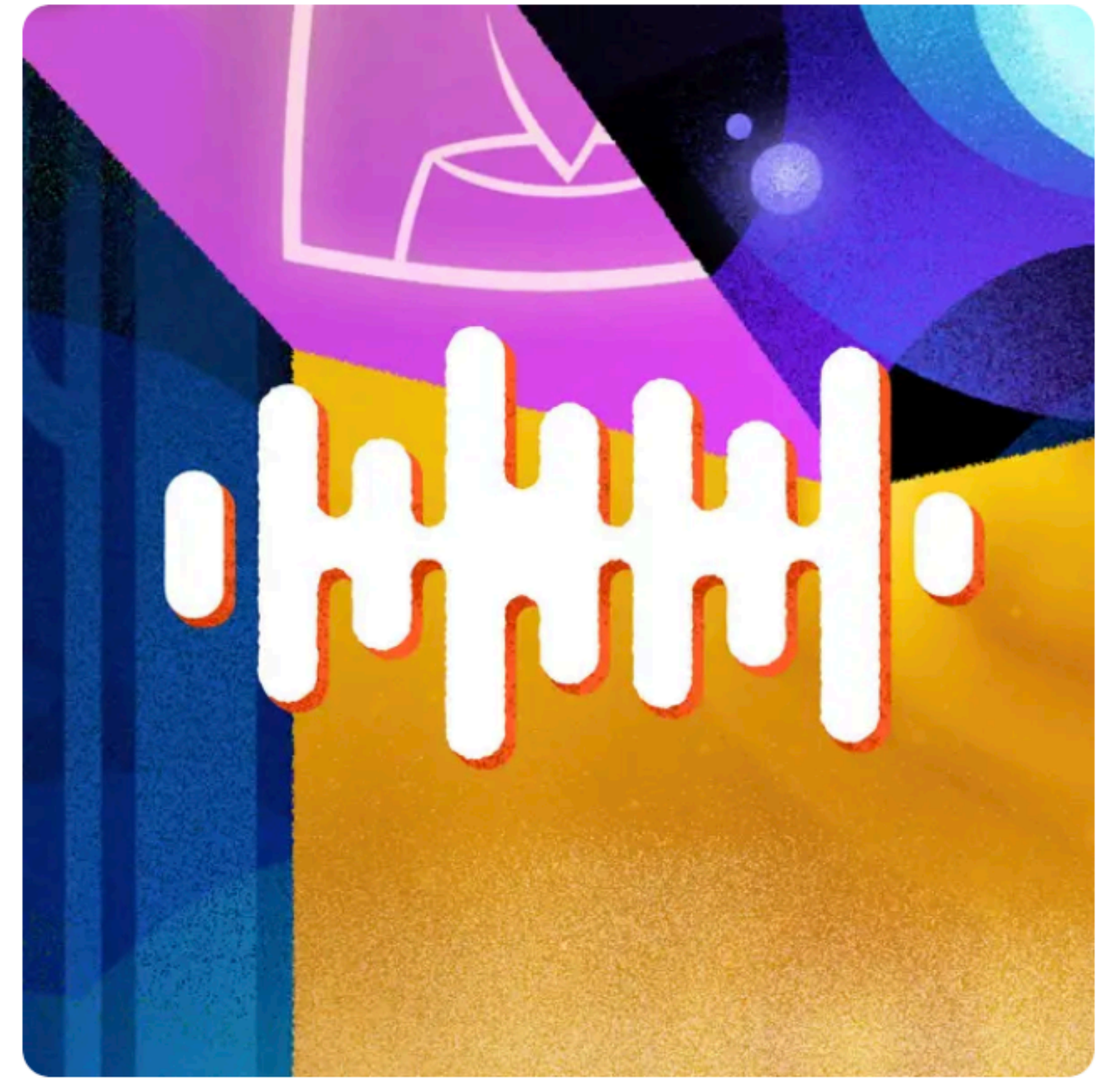

STAGES OF COURTSHIP

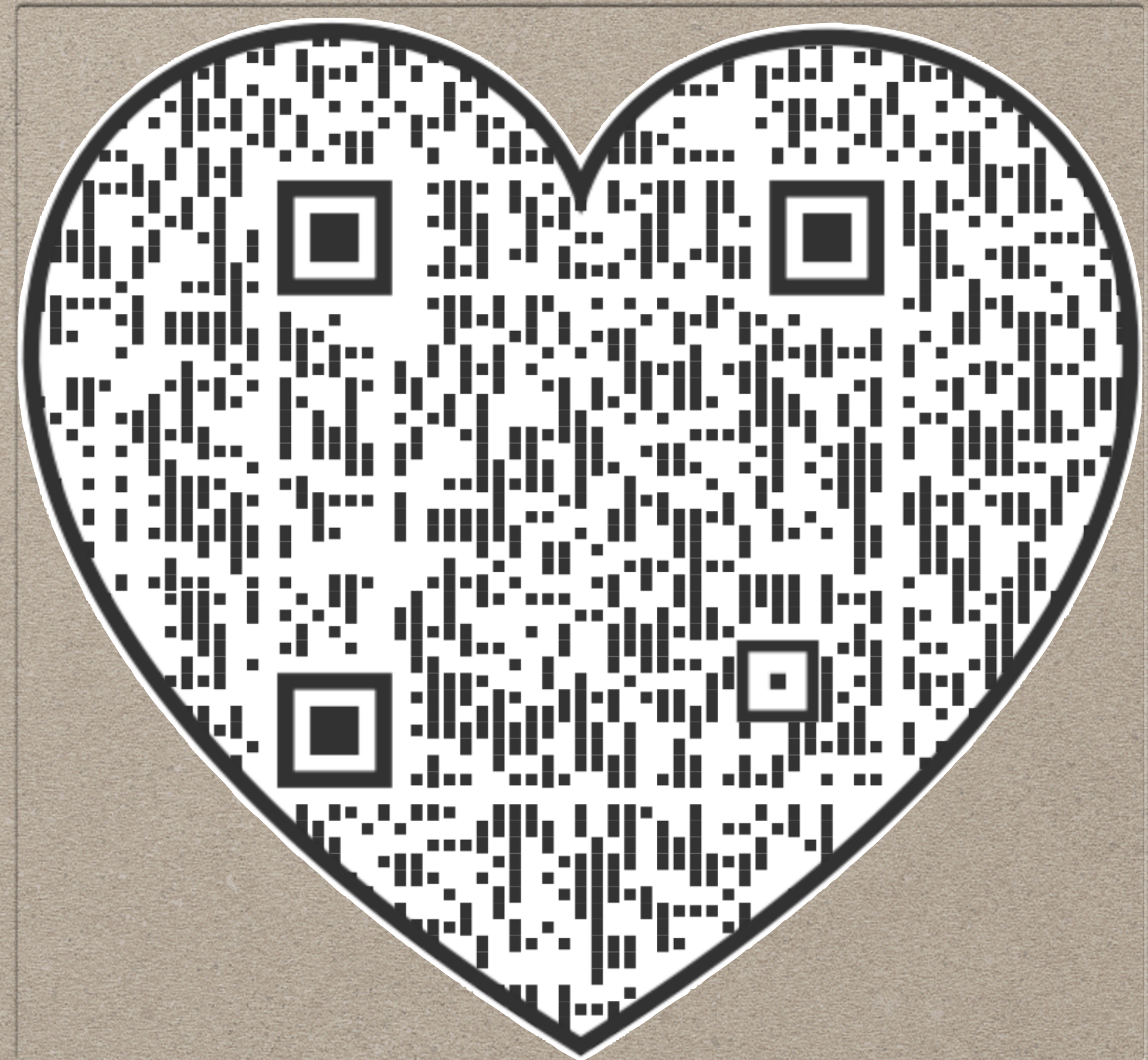
1. **Noticing** attractive traits in someone:
