Matthew 1:18

Now the birth of Jesus...

She was found with child...

1 Corinthians 14:33 (NKJV) For God is not the author of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints.

Matthew 1:19

Then Joseph her husband...

“Just” = “right or righteous”

John 8:2–5

Micah 6:8 (NKJV) He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?

Verses 20-23 Christmas Brings Comfort...

Matthew 1:20-21

But while he thought...

Galatians 4:4–5 (NKJV) 4 But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, 5 to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

Joseph, son of David...

Romans 1:3 (NKJV) concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh...

Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.
