Living as scattered people - Luke 4:1-20

1 What does it mean for the Church to be "scattered," and how does this impact how we live out our faith daily?

2 Jesus' parable emphasizes the act of sowing rather than the soil—how does this change your perspective on evangelism and discipleship?

3 Have you ever felt discouraged when sharing your faith due to a lack of visible results? How does this sermon encourage you to keep casting the seed?

4 Which type of soil do you most relate to in different seasons of your spiritual journey, and why?

5 How can we balance being part of the gathered church (learning, worship, community) with our role as the scattered church (living out our faith in the world)?

6 How is your "casting arm"? Are you actively sharing God's Word where you are planted, and if not, what is holding you back?

7 What practical steps can you take to be more intentional about planting seeds in your workplace, family, or community? How is your scattering of seeds affecting the lives of those around you? - [Matthew 5:14-16 \(NIV\)](#)
