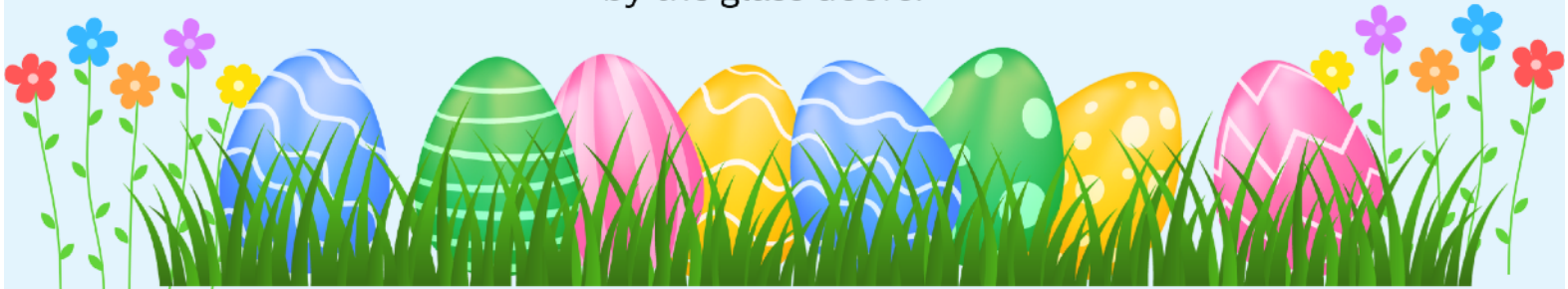
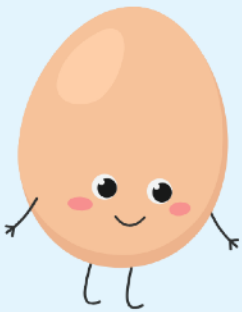

**THE LIMITLESS POTENTIAL OF HOPE**

**So what happens when we die?  
What can we expect at the Second Coming of Jesus?  
Few topics stir up more emotions: both positive and negative, than the End Times.**

1 Thessalonians 4:18

<sup>18</sup> Therefore encourage each other with these words.

**Paul's purpose for writing about the return of Jesus was to encourage the Thessalonians, and by extension, to encourage, to strengthen our faith, to unite us together, and to spur us on to live faithful lives as we prepare for Jesus' return.**

**Hope is the motivation to live holy lives.  
It is the inspiration to stand strong even amid persecution.**

**As Christians, we grieve differently.**

1 Thessalonians 4:13

<sup>13</sup> Brothers, we do not want you to be ignorant about those who fall asleep, or to grieve like the rest of men, who have no hope.

**Even in the face of death, we grieve with hope because  
of the promise of the resurrection.**

1 Thessalonians 4:14

**The Promise of the Resurrection**

<sup>14</sup> We believe that Jesus died and rose again and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him.

**We live with assurance that death is not the end for those of us in Christ. We will be reunited with loved ones who have passed away in Christ.**

1 Thessalonians 4:15

<sup>15</sup> According to the Lord's own word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left till the coming of the Lord, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep.

**The return of Christ will be unmistakable, not a secret.**

1 Thessalonians 4:16

<sup>16</sup> For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.

1 Thessalonians 4:17-18

**The Rapture and The Day of the Lord**

<sup>17</sup> After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. <sup>18</sup> Therefore encourage each other with these words.

**The Day of the Lord will come unexpectedly**

1 Thessalonians 5:1-3

<sup>1</sup> Now, brothers and sisters, about times and dates we do not need to write to you, <sup>2</sup> for you know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. <sup>3</sup> While people are saying, "Peace and safety," destruction will come on them suddenly, as labor pains on a pregnant woman, and they will not escape.

**It ought to shape our daily decisions and actions.**

**We are called to live differently—avoiding sin and living holy lives as we wait.**
