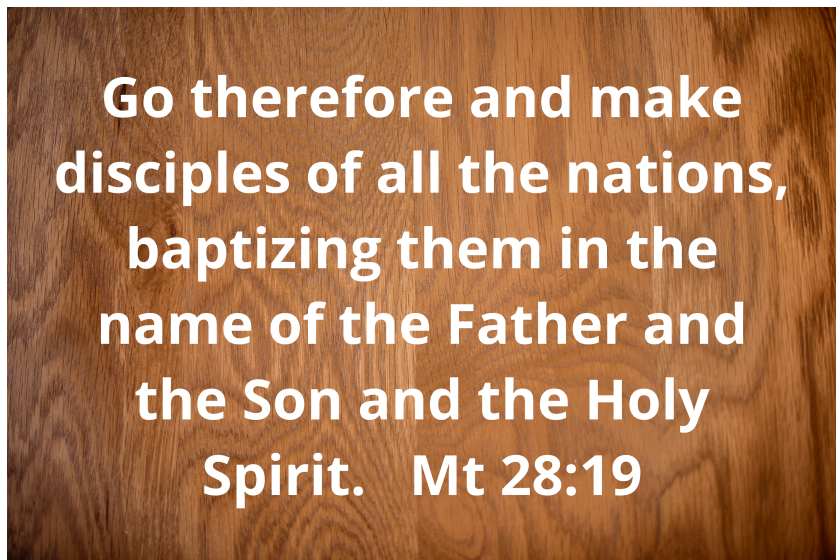
Disc Golf Ministry

In 2022 we installed a 9-basket, 18 hole disc golf course here on our property. This course is open to the public (after notifying our course director). We have a disc golf club here at the church who plays competitively against each other and uses disc golf as an outreach in our local community. Christ's Church Disc Golf League plays most weekends from April - October. We will be playing at least 2 rounds per month at our church course and welcome everyone to join us- we'll even teach you how to play.

Ministry Minute

Romans 6:1-23
