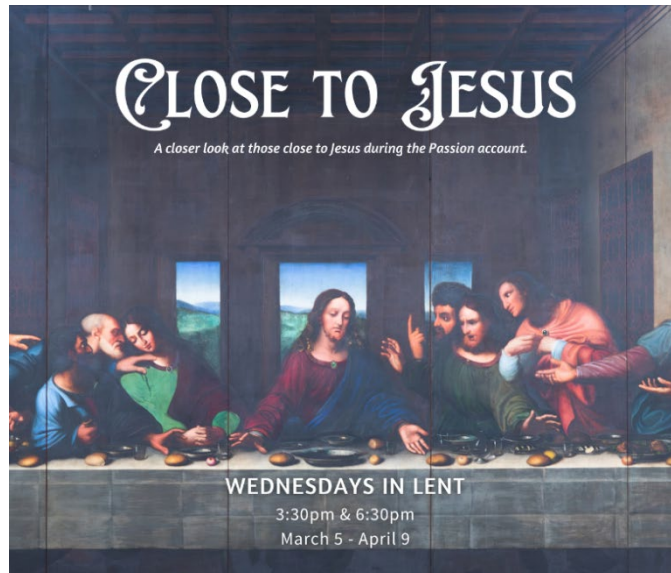

On Good Friday, an old practice at Trinity returns: the **Tre Ore**.

Trinity celebrated a Tre Ore service for many years at both the old church downtown and in our present sanctuary. Tre Ore means, “three hours” and focuses on the final three hours of Jesus’ crucifixion. The service begins at noon and continues until three with seven individual services happening within those three hours. The services will each last approximately 20 minutes, with the final one lasting approximately 30 minutes, and will include sermons from area LCMS pastors. You are free to come to all of the services, or one of them—whatever your schedule allows.

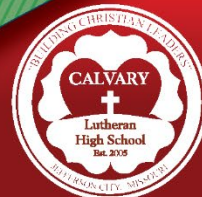
