- B. Notice the name written in the foreheads of the 144,000.
- C. Satan tries to emulate God's system. *Revelation 13:18; 7:3-8 ; 9:21; 14:8; 1 Timothy 4:1-3*

- D. These male virgins were redeemed (past tense) from the earth. ***Song of Solomon 1:3; Matthew 19:12 ; Matthew 25:7; Revelation 7:1-8; Revelation 11:12; Psalm 45:14; Revelation 19:1-5***
- E. The 144,000 escape the winepress. ***Jude 14,24; Revelation 12:17; Matthew 24:19-20; Matthew 24:13.***
- F. They are the firstfruits unto God and the Lamb. ***Revelation 14:4, Romans 16:5, Matthew 24:13***
- G. They have no guile. ***Revelation 14:5***
- H. They are without fault before the throne of God. ***Revelation 14:5***
