Paschal Candle

The name 'Paschal' comes from the Hebrew word Pesach which means Passover. In the Church, at the Saturday vigil before Easter Sunday, a 'new' fire is lit. The candle is then lit from this sacred fire. There are four key symbols on the paschal candle: the five wounds, the cross, the year and the alpha and omega.
