

2 SAMUEL 2: 8 - 11 (NASB. 1977)

- BUT ABNER THE SON OF NER, COMMANDER OF SAUL'S ARMY, HAD TAKEN ISH-BOSHETH THE SON OF SAUL, AND BROUGHT HIM OVER TO MAHANAIM.
- AND HE MADE HIM KING OVER GILEAD, OVER THE ASHURITES, OVER JEZREEL, OVER EPHRAIM, AND OVER BENJAMIN, EVEN OVER ALL ISRAEL.
- ISH-BOSHETH, SAUL'S SON, WAS FORTY YEARS OLD WHEN HE BECAME KING OVER ISRAEL, AND HE WAS KING FOR TWO YEARS. THE HOUSE OF JUDAH, HOWEVER, FOLLOWED DAVID.
- → AND THE TIME THAT DAVID WAS KING IN HEBRON OVER THE HOUSE OF JUDAH WAS SEVEN YEARS AND SIX MONTHS.



TWO CAMPS 2 Samuel 2: 8, 9

THE ACTIONS TAKEN BY ABNER IS ESSENTIALLY
A REFUSAL TO ACCEPT THE END OF SAUL'S KINGDOM.

IT WAS REBELLION AGAINST THE NEW KING

THIS WAS IN SPITE OF HIM BEING PRESENT AT SAUL'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF DAVID AS KING -

"AND NOW, BEHOLD, I KNOW THAT YOU SHALL SURELY BE KING, AND THAT THE KINGDOM OF ISRAEL SHALL BE ESTABLISHED IN YOUR HAND"

1 SAMUEL 24: 20 (ESV)

MAHANAIM (lit."TWO CAMPS")

2 Samuel 2: 8, 12

MAHANAIM IS CENTRAL TO THE REGION EAST OF JORDAN, KNOWN AS GILEAD

ABOUT 15 MILES SOUTH OF JABESH-GILEAD

BY THE JABBOK RIVER THAT FLOWS WEST INTO THE JORDAN RIVER

ORIGINALLY NAMED BY JACOB WHEN HE MET 2 ANGELS. IT WAS ALSO WHERE HE DIVIDED HIS COMPANY INTO "TWO CAMPS" (Genesis 32: 2, 7, 10)



THE IRONY OF ABNER'S CHOICE OF MAHANAIM AS ISH-BOSHETH'S CAPITAL —

HE WAS, BY HIS ACTIONS, DIVIDING THE PEOPLE OF ISRAEL INTO TWO CAMPS.

IN MAKING THE NORTHERN TRIBES CHOSE A
KING OTHER THAN DAVID, A CHAIN OF EVENTS
WAS SET IN MOTION THAT WOULD ULTIMATELY
LEAD TO THE EMERGENCE OF TWO KINGDOMS
"ISRAEL" AND "JUDAH" AFTER SOLOMON'S
DEATH





IT IS VERY DIFFICULT TO ELIMINATE DIVISION ONCE ITS SEED IS SOWN AND TOLERATED 2 SAMUEL 2: 8 – 11; MATTHEW 13: 24 – 30

ONCE THE SEED OF DIVISION IS ALLOWED TO GROW, IT BECOMES LIKE A WEED THAT IS VERY DIFFICULT TO REMOVE

NOT ONLY ARE WEEDS HARD TO REMOVE BUT THEY CAN BE INDISTINGUISHABLE FROM, AND INTERTWINED WITH, THE WHEAT.

IT IS LIKE TWO DIFFERENT AGENDAS AT WORK IN THE KINGDOM OF GOD

WE NEED TO HEED THE PARABLE OF THE WEEDS AND THE WHEAT (Matthew 13: 24 -30). THE BATTLES WE FIGHT ARE SPIRITUAL AND NOT JUST POLITICAL.

nb. The word used in Matthew is 'darnel' – a weed resembling wheat

WE NEED TO BE AWARE THAT BY CHOOSING TO FOLLOW CHRIST, TO HAVE HIM AS OUR KING,

WE ENTER A SPIRITUAL CONFLICT.

SO DON'T BE SURPRISED WHEN YOU ENCOUNTER CONFLICT.
HIS KINGDOM WILL COME – ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN.

2 SAMUEL 3: 1, 6 (NASB. 1977)

► NOW THERE WAS A LONG WAR BETWEEN THE HOUSE OF SAUL AND THE HOUSE OF DAVID;

AND DAVID GREW STEADILY STRONGER,
BUT THE HOUSE OF SAUL GREW WEAKER CONTINUALLY

→ AND IT CAME ABOUT WHILE THERE WAS WAR BETWEEN THE HOUSE OF SAUL AND THE HOUSE OF DAVID

THAT ABNER WAS MAKING HIMSELF STRONG
IN THE HOUSE OF SAUL.

A COMPLEX CHARACTER WHO REFUSED TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE WORK OF GOD (a)

- SON OF NER, BROTHER TO KISH, SAUL'S FATHER; COUSIN TO SAUL (1 Samuel 14:50,51)
- COMMANDER OF SAUL'S ARMY WHO HAD WITNESSED DAVID KILLING GOLIATH (1Samuel 14:50; 17:55)
- BROUGHT DAVID TO SAUL (1 Samuel 17:57); SHARED A PLACE WITH DAVID AT SAUL'S TABLE (1 Samuel 20:25)
- WITNESSED SAUL'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF DAVID'S FUTURE AT LEAST TWICE (1 Samuel 24:20; 26:25)
- ► YET REFUSED HIMSELF TO ACKNOWLEDGE DAVID AS KING FOLLOWING SAUL'S DEATH & INFLUENCED ISRAEL TO CHOOSE ANOTHER KING



A COMPLEX CHARACTER WHO REFUSED TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE WORK OF GOD (b)

- THAT HIS ACTIONS WERE AN INCITE TO ISRAEL TO REBEL AGAINST THE LORD AND TO PROVOKE A CIVIL WAR.
- A LAWLESS MAN WHO TRIED TO RULE OVER ISRAEL INSTEAD OF GOD.
- A PROVOCATEUR AFTER 2 YEARS, MOVES HIS ARMY TO GIBEON, 5 MILES FROM DAVID'S BORDER (2 Samuel 2:12)
- A DOUBLE-CROSSER WHO FALLS OUT WITH HIS PUPPET KING AND DEFECTS TO DAVID



A COMPLEX CHARACTER WHO REFUSED TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE WORK OF GOD (c)

- A SMOOTH-TALKER WHO CONVINCES JOAB TO BE MERCIFUL BECAUSE 'UNITY MATTERS MORE THAN THE LORD'S NAME' (2 Samuel 2: 24- 29)
- A SELF-SERVING MAN WHO LOOKED OUT FOR HIMSELF
- ATTEMPTS TO WIN DAVID OVER BY PROMISING
- (i) THAT IF THEY ENTERED A COVENANT HE WOULD 'BRING ALL ISRAEL OVER TO' DAVID (2 Samuel 3:12);
 - (ii) TO TURN HIM INTO A KING LIKE SAUL SO THAT DAVID
 'MAY BE KING OVER ALL [HIS] SOUL DESIRES' (2 Samuel 3: 21)



ABNER WAS MAKING HIMSELF STRONG IN THE HOUSE OF SAUL (2 Samuel 3:6)

ABNER WAS CLEVER AND AMBITIOUS –
HE WAS A MAN WHO MADE THINGS HAPPEN
HE INITIATED THINGS

HE PLOTTED TO ENSURE THAT EVENTS WENT HIS WAY & FOR HIS ADVANTAGE

ALL THE MACHINATIONS OF MEN ALWAYS WILL COME TO NOTHING BEFORE GOD.



THEN ABNER SENT MESSENGERS TO DAVID...NOW ABNER HAD CONSULTATION WITH THE ELDERS OF ISRAEL...

(2 Samuel 3:7-21-6)

DISAPPOINTMENT & DISILLUSIONMENT WITH ISH-BOSHETH SETS IN

DISAGREEMENT OCCURS

ABNER REACHES OUT
TO DAVID AS WELL AS THE ELDERS OF ISRAEL

BUT

CONTINUES TO PLOT









WAS ABNER'S BEHAVIOUR DIFFERENT AFTER HIS CHANGE OF ALLEGIANCE?

2 SAMUEL 3: 12 - 21

THERE IS NOTHING AS SAD AS A SELF-DELUDED MAN

(1 Samuel 15:20; 2 Samuel 3:6, 9,10,12)

HIS BEHAVIOUR WAS SELF-SERVING.

ABNER NEVER CONFESSES HIS OWN FAILURES.

HE NEVER ADMITTED THAT

a) HE WAS WRONG TO MAKE ISH-BOSHETH KING;

b) HE ACTED AS THOUGH ISRAEL WERE HIS OWN PEOPLE;

c) HE TRIED TO USE HIS OWN CLEVERNESS AND POWER

TO DEFY GOD'S PURPOSES.

HIS ARROGANCE KNEW NO BOUNDS HE OVERESTIMATED HIS POWER





THE LORD LONGS FOR A PEOPLE WITH A PASSION FOR HIS NAME (Matthew 6:24)

PROUD & DISOBEDIENT PEOPLE WHO FAIL TO HONOUR HIS NAME WILL FALL

MANY ALTERNATIVES SEEK OUR ALLERGENCE TODAY, BUT YOU CANNOT SERVE TWO MASTERS. THERE CAN ONLY BE ONE ULTIMATELY

OUR KING IS JESUS. HIS KINGDOM IS GOD'S KINGDOM. ARE YOU WILLING TO FOLLOW JESUS AND HIS REIGN OR ARE YOU DRAWN TO SOMETHING ELSE?

NOW THERE WAS A LONG WAR BETWEEN THE HOUSE OF SAUL AND THE HOUSE OF DAVID

DAVID'S KINGDOM IN THE EARLY DAYS WAS LIKE THE KINGDOM OF JESUS;

BY HIS DEATH, JESUS DEFEATED HIS ENEMIES
BY HIS RESURRECTION HE HAS BEEN DECLARED AS GOD'S KING.

HOWEVER, HIS KINGDOM IS NOT YET UNIVERSALLY ACKNOWLEDGED.

ENEMIES OPPOSE HIM WHILE RIVALS VIE FOR POWER (1 Corinthians 15:25)



AND DAVID GREW STEADILY STRONGER, BUT THE HOUSE OF SAUL GREW WEAKER CONTINUALLY

THE KINGDOM OF JESUS IS GROWING STRONGER AND STRONGER.

THERE MAY BE TIMES WHEN YOU CANNOT SEE THIS TRUTH ESPECIALLY WHEN YOU ARE IN THE THICK OF THE STRUGGLE

BUT THE TRUTH IS...

GOD IS AT WORK, SOVEREIGN OVER ALL HUMAN WICKEDNESS, FOOLISHNESS, AND WEAKNESSES.

GOD IS ESTABLISHING HIS KINGDOM AND HIS KING AND HE WILL COMPLETE WHAT HE STARTED





POWER IN THE HANDS OF HUMAN BEINGS IS NEVER COMPLETELY WISE AND GOOD

(John Woodhouse, 2015)

A SAD STORY OF POLITICS, AMBITION, REVENGE AND GREED. BUT ALSO ONE OF HOPE AND A DEMONSTRATION OF GOD'S SOVEREIGN RULE

MAN'S ATTEMPTS TO INFLUENCE THE COMING OF GOD'S KINGDOM OR TO TURN EVENTS TO TO THEIR OWN ADVANTAGE WILL EVENTUALLY FAIL

NO ONE IS WISE ENOUGH, GOOD ENOUGH, OR POWERFUL ENOUGH TO ACCOMPLISH WHAT MAN INTENDED – ONLY GOD – AND HE WILL DO WHAT HE WILL DO. GOD WILL SEE TO IT.



#3a

2 SAMUEL 5: 1 - 5 (NASB. 1977)

- THEN ALL THE TRIBES OF ISRAEL CAME TO DAVID AT HEBRON AND SAID, "BEHOLD, WE ARE YOUR BONE AND YOUR FLESH."
 - "PREVIOUSLY, WHEN SAUL WAS KING OVER US, YOU WERE THE ONE WHO LED ISRAEL OUT AND IN. AND THE LORD SAID TO YOU, 'YOU WILL SHEPHERD MY PEOPLE ISRAEL, AND YOU WILL BE A RULER OVER ISRAEL.'"
 - SO ALL THE ELDERS OF ISRAEL CAME TO THE KING AT HEBRON, AND KING DAVID MADE A COVENANT WITH THEM BEFORE THE LORD AT HEBRON; THEN THEY ANOINTED DAVID KING OVER ISRAEL
- DAVID WAS THIRTY YEARS OLD WHEN HE BECAME KING, AND HE REIGNED FORTY YEARS
 - AT HEBRON HE REIGNED OVER JUDAH SEVEN YEARS AND SIX MONTHS, AND IN JERUSALEM HE REIGNED THIRTY-THREE YEARS OVER ALL ISRAEL AND JUDAH

THEN ALL THE TRIBES OF ISRAEL CAME TO DAVID AT HEBRON

THE ELDERS HAD HEARD THE GOOD NEWS OF THE KINGDOM OF DAVID FROM ABNER (2 Samuel 3:17, 18) AND IT WAS GOOD TO THEM (2 Samuel 3: 19)

THEY & ALL ISRAEL WERE HOWEVER DISTURBED WHEN THEY HEARD OF ABNER'S DEATH (2 Samuel 4:1)

BUT DAVID'S BEHAVIOUR AND HONOURING OF ABNER CONVINCED THEM THAT ABNER'S DEATH WAS NOT DAVID'S DOING (2 Samuel 3: 37)

ISH-BOSHETH'S DEATH REMOVED ANY REMAINING OBSTACLE TO THE NORTHERN TRIBES TO ACCEPT DAVID AS THEIR KING (2 Samuel 3:17) – THERE WAS NO LONGER ANY REASON TO DELAY.



FAITH COMES FROM HEARING, AND HEARING BY THE WORD OF GOD

(Romans 10:17, NASB)

THE MEANS BY WHICH PEOPLE COME TO THEIR SENSES IS HEARING THE GOOD NEWS OF THE KINGDOM OF JESUS CHRIST

PEOPLE MAY HAVE OBSTACLES & EXCUSES THAT STAND IN THE WAY OF COMING TO CHRIST.

BUT IF THE GOSPEL IS PROCLAIMED AND HEARD WITHOUT FEAR OR FAVOUR, SUCH HINDERANCES (IN WHATEVER FORM THEY MAY BE) WILL BE SWEPT AWAY (2 Corinthians 10: 4,5)



3 REASONS WHY THE ELDERS CAME TO DAVID AT HEBRON

(2 Samuel 5: 2, NASB)

a) "WE ARE YOUR BONE AND YOUR FLESH" Lit. WE ARE YOUR BODY. THEY ACKNOWLEDGED DAVID AS KING. THEY REALISED WHO THEY WERE IN RELATION TO DAVID

b) "WHEN SAUL WAS KING...YOU WERE THE ONE WHO LED ISRAEL OUT AND IN" Lit. "YOU ARE OUR SAVIOUR". ISRAEL CAME TO THEIR SENSES AND SAW THAT EVEN WHEN SAUL WAS KING, DAVID WAS THEIR SAVIOUR.

c) "YOU ARE OUR SHEPHERD" THE TRIBES COMING TO DAVID AT HEBRON IS A WONDERFUL PICTURE OF WHAT IT MEANS TODAY FOR PEOPLE TO COME TO GOD'S KING – JESUS CHRIST!

THEN ALL THE TRIBES OF ISRAEL CAME TO DAVID AT HEBRON..SO ALL THE ELDERS OF ISRAEL CAME TO THE KING AT HEBRON..

THE FACT THAT IS UNDERLINED HERE IS THAT THE ELDERS CAME TO DAVID AT HEBRON.

DAVID DID NOT GO TO THEM AT MAHANAIM.

DAVID DID NOT TAKE THE LEADERSHIP OF ISRAEL THAT WAS ABOUT TO BECOME HIS;

HE <u>RECEIVED</u> IT.



AND KING DAVID MADE A COVENANT WITH THEM BEFORE THE LORD AT HEBRON; THEN THEY ANOINTED DAVID KING OVER ISRAEL

WHAT HAD BEGUN IN 1 SAMUEL 16:1 HAD NOW REACHED ITS GOAL.
DAVID WAS NOW KING OVER ISRAEL (2 SAMUEL 5:3)

DAVID WAS NOW TAKING CENTRE STAGE AND WE ARE ABOUT TO SEE WHAT GOD CAN DO THROUGH A PERSON WHO LOVES HIS NAME.

THROUGH ALL THE TRIALS, TOILS AND SNARES,
GOD'S GRACE AND PURPOSE WILL ALWAYS PREVAIL



BEING FAITHFUL DOES NOT MEAN THAT EVERYTHING MAKES SENSE OR THAT YOU ARE HAPPY WITH YOUR SITUATION

BEING FAITHFUL TO GOD DOES NOT MEAN THAT YOU CANNOT TAKE YOUR SITUATION TO THE LORD

YOU CAN COMPLAIN – BUT DON'T COMPLAIN <u>ABOUT</u>
GOD BUT COMPLAIN <u>TO</u> GOD (eg Psalm 6 & 13)
