Read the Text - Matthew 28:16-20

Questions for Reflection & Discussion:

- Write in your journal or share with others about how the Great Commission has shaped your life. Reflect on the most significant encounters you have had with those doing the work of global evangelism. How has their faithfulness been an encouragement to you?
- 2. Read the verses immediately before the Great Commission (Matt. 28:11-15). How do the actions in those verses directly contrast the actions of Jesus in verses 16-20?
- 3. What are some of the obstacles or challenges that keep us from going and making disciples?
- 4. What is so hopeful about the way that Jesus concludes the Great Commission? Talk about how the promise of Jesus' continuing presence helps us face our fears and encounter the world in a way that glorifies God and builds up his church.
- 5. What excites you about the Global Encounter initiative at CMBC? Who do you know that might be a great candidate? Let Emily know this week, (hint, maybe it's you).
- 6. Take a look through the Global Outreach Conference brochure for this year's conference, and make note of three sessions throughout the week that you are looking forward to participating in.

Questions guiding Spiritual Formation & Application:

- 1. How does this text invite us to grow in a greater love for God?
- 2. What lessons within this text move us towards growing in our love for one another?
- 3. What principles could be applied to our family life, careers, communities, or congregational life?
- 4. Consider how Jesus could use our application of the principles in this text to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?
- 5. Who is currently in our lives that needs an invitation to meet Jesus or be part of a kind and gracious Christian community?
