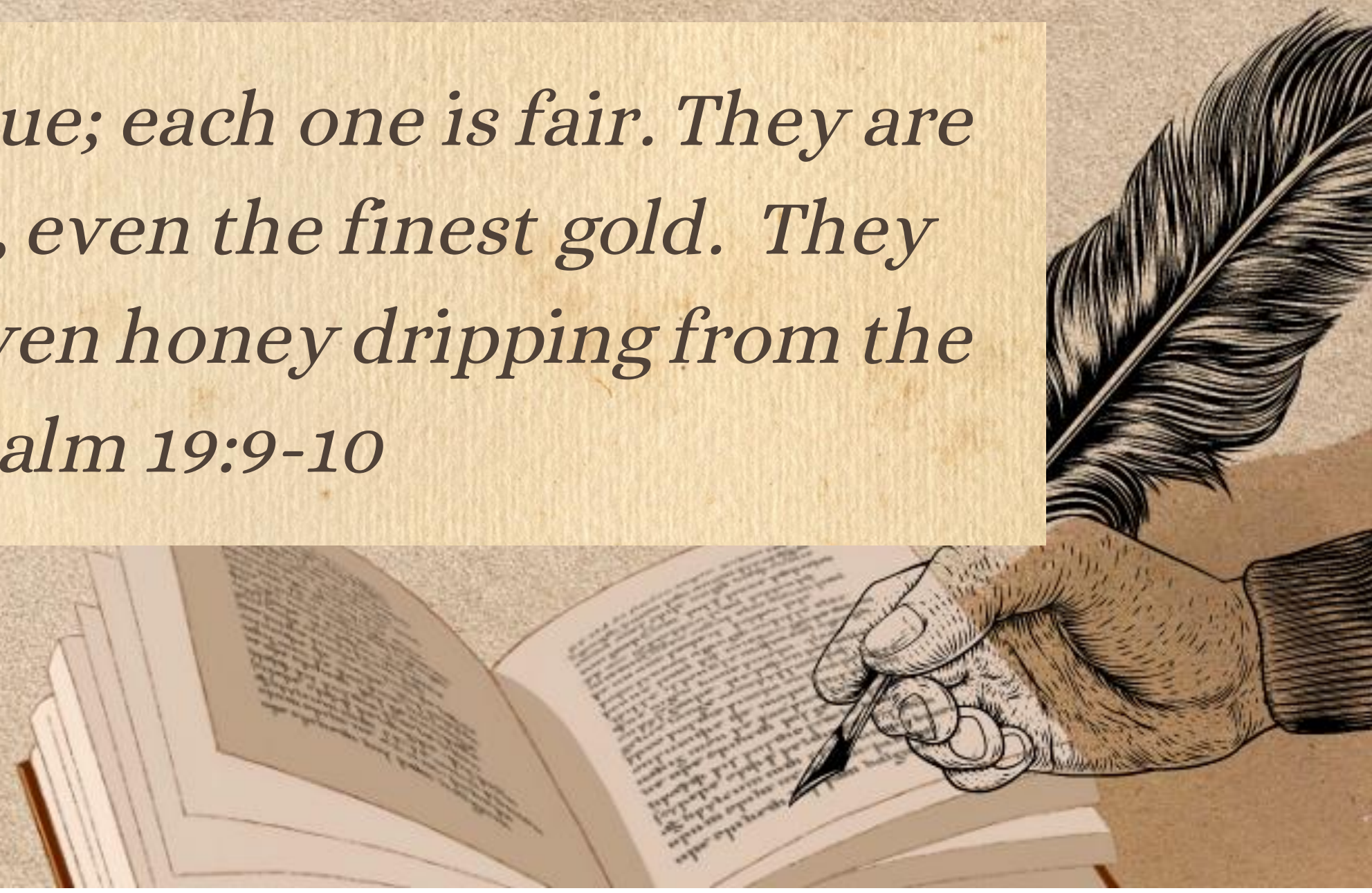






## Joshua 1:8 NKJV
