Have two people read Romans 13:8-14, from two different translations.

1. In vs 8, Paul says, “Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another.” In what ways does understanding that you can never settle the debt you owe regarding love for others impact the way you love people?
2. What is one habit or attitude that is making it hard for you to love others well? What’s one step you can take this week to surrender that to God?
3. In what relationships—family, work, church, or neighborhood—have you been withholding love or compassion? What will you do to "repay" that debt?
4. What’s one area of your life (time, money, priorities) that needs to change if you were truly living like Christ could return any day?
5. What does it mean to “put aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light?” How can we actively do this in our lives?
6. Verse 14 says to “clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ?” In what relationships or environments do you struggle to reflect Jesus? What’s one way you can consciously “put on Christ” in that space this week?
